Launch Imperfectly, Iterate Rapidly


Reject Perfectionism

The 72-Hour Rule




For any new idea or learned lesson, commit to taking tangible action within 72 hours. This discipline transforms insight into impact.

Now is the Only Window

Be Perpetually Ready


Constant Adaptability

Lead with Hope, Absorb Fear




Internalize Anxiety



Find organizational complexity that slows innovation


Eliminate Bureaucracy

Don't just react to trends—understand the underlying shift driving them.


Identify Foundational Changes

Align Strategy




Proactively define your next major iteration. Don't wait until your current identity runs out of momentum.
